We have had our second cohort of children start in Reception and they have all settled in really well and are beginning to learn their teachers' names and class routine. They have been exploring and taking part in a range of activities in their classroom as well as learning our school rules in a creative way. The Reception teachers want to say a great big well done to all the children for trying their best to come to school with a smile and a positive attitude.

Well done to all children for their first full week in Year 1. They have had a busy week getting their first-hand experience of the KS1 curriculum. In PSHE we have been talking about different ways of helping each other learn. In English we have been learning the traditional rhymes Incy Wincy Spider, Five Little Monkeys, Twinkle Twinkle Little Star, Row, Row, Row Your Boat and Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall through a range of fun activities. In Maths we have been learning to count forwards and backwards within 50 and learning to tackle the 'teens' and 'ty' such as thirteen and thirty. In geography we have been learning to find out how the seasons are linked with the months of the year. Identifying, naming and comparing the parts of the body was exciting in our science lesson. Parents, please have a look in your child's book bag for their first homework and spelling words.

Road safety

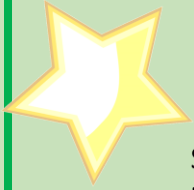
We have noticed that some parents are double parking when dropping their children off this restricts the other cars movement and narrows the road.
