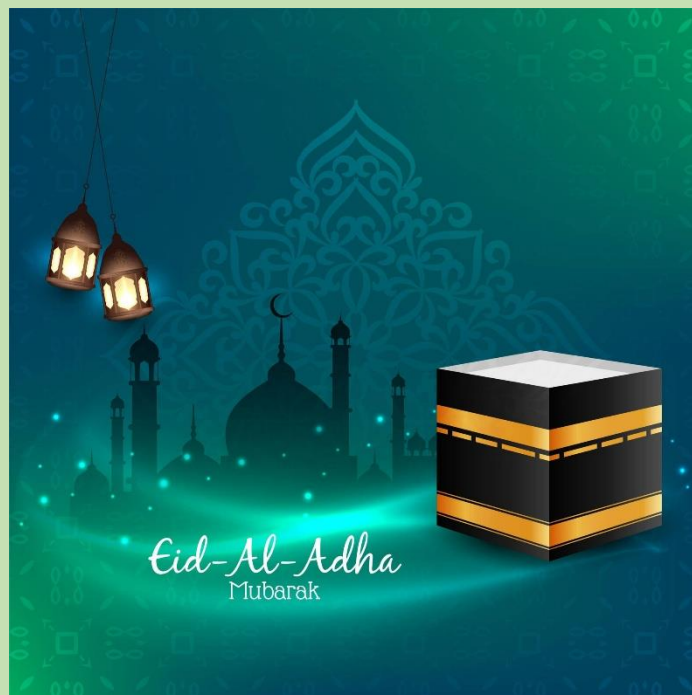

I would also like to on behalf of the staff, wish all our muslim families a very Happy Eid -ul-Adha.

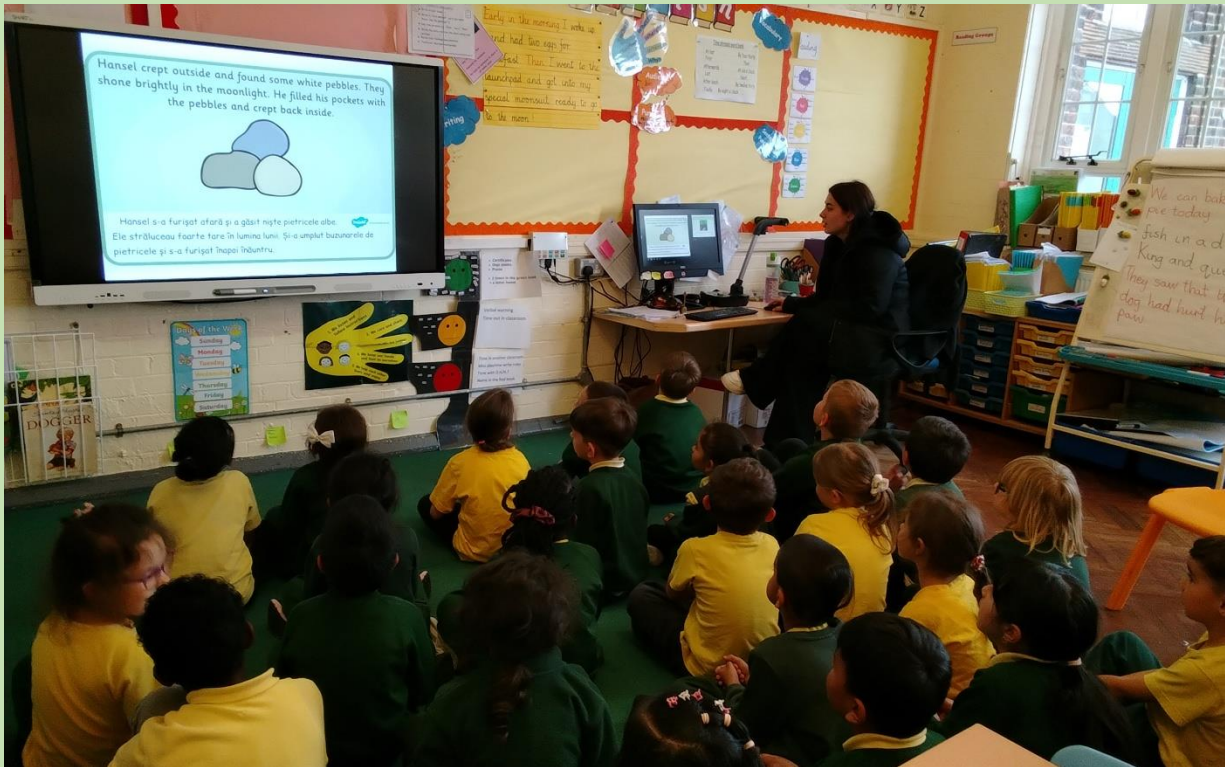


Eid parties will take place on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. A letter will be sent out this week..
