Dear Parents,

This week, the children have been enjoying learning outside and taking advantage of the beautiful weather! Please make sure that you put sun screen on your child before they come in to school and that your child comes to school wearing a sun hat, so that they are protected from the sun.



Many of the children are coming into school wearing sleeveless clothing. Please ensure that you provide a cardigan/ jumper for your child to wear in case they feel cold.

Reminder – NO OPEN-TOED SANDALS!

Please do not send your child to school wearing open-toed sandals. These can get caught in the Nursery equipment, causing your child to fall and hurt themselves.

Reception Visits

If your child has got a place in a Reception class at our school, you will soon receive a confirmation email regarding this from our school. Please make sure that you complete all of the relevant paperwork attached and email it to the school office as soon as possible. You will be contacted again on Monday 24th June with details of when to visit the school and meet the Reception team.

In order to prepare your child for the change in their class, the Nursery staff will be taking small groups of children over to visit their new classes over the next few weeks. The transition between the Nursery and Reception can often be traumatic for children. Therefore, it is important that you talk to your child positively about this change in order to prepare them for September.

Home Learning: 10th – 14th June 2024

Next week, we will be learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development/ Communication & Language:

- To talk about some of the things that I can do and some food I can eat to help me be healthy.
- To talk about why we love our daddies/families.

Physical Development:

- To use a pencil with good control and to be able to write our names. If your child still finds it difficult to hold a pencil correctly, please practice this skill at home with your child.
