Home Learning: 8th – 12th July 2024

Next week we will be learning:

- To talk about how we feel about finishing our Nursery year and going to our Reception class in September. At home, please talk to your child positively about moving from Nursery to Reception in order to prepare them for this change.
- To adapt behaviour to different social situations and changes in routine.

Physical Development:

- To hold a pencil with a comfortable grip and use it with good control. Many of the children are now forming the letters in their name beautifully. At home, please help your child to form the letters in their name correctly.
- To negotiate space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.
- It would be nice if your child could wear their team colour on Sports Day. (The Nursery staff will tell you the colour of the team that your child is in.)

Communication & Language:

- To respond to simple instructions.

Literacy:

- We will be revising all of the letter names and sounds of the alphabet.

Mathematics:

- To count up to at least 10 in sequence.
- To use ordinal language e.g. 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
