Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Physical Development:

• To be able to hold a pen or pencil with a comfortable grip. If your child finds this difficult, please practice this skill at home.

Communication & Language / Understanding the World:

- We will continue to observe the changes in the chicks and talk about the life cycle of a chicken.
- The children will also be handling the chicks.

Literacy:

 We will be learning the letter name and sound 'w' for example, web, wind and wellington boots. Please bring in an object from home beginning with the letter name and sound 'w' to share with the class.

Mathematics:

 To learn to count in sequence and understand that the last number reached tells you how many there are in the total. At home, you could set out different sets of objects and encourage your child to count how many there are, pointing to each object as they count.

Expressive Arts & Design:

• We will be painting pictures of the chicks.
