Next week, we are learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To talk about how we feel about finishing our Nursery year and going to our Reception class in September. At home, please talk to your child about moving from Nursery to Reception in order to prepare them for this change.
- To adapt behaviour to different social situations and changes in routine.

Physical Development:

- To hold a pencil with a comfortable grip and use it with good control. Many of the children are now forming the letters in their name beautifully. At home, please help your child to form the letters in their name correctly.

Communication & Language:

- To respond to simple instructions.

Literacy:

- We will be revising all of the letter names and sounds of the alphabet. Your child can practise singing all of the Jolly Phonics songs at home on YouTube. Here is a link:

- To count up to at least 10 in sequence.
