## Home Learning: 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022

### Next week we will be learning:

#### **Personal, Social and Emotional Development:**

- To accept the needs of others and take turns and share resources, sometimes with support from others.
- We will be visiting our new Reception classes over the next 2 weeks. At home, please talk to your child about them moving to Reception after the summer holidays, in order to make the transition easier.

#### **Physical Development:**

- To negotiate space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles. Please make sure that your child comes to school wearing appropriate clothing and foot wear every day next week, as we will be practising our races.

#### **Communication & Language:**

- To respond to simple instructions.

#### **Literacy:**

- We will be revising all of the letter names and sounds of the alphabet.
- We will be making 'information cards' for our Reception teachers.

#### **Mathematics:**

- To use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting.

#### **Reminder:**
