Dear Parents,

This week in the Nursery, we have been reading the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. The children have been talking about the characters in the story and joining in with the repeated words that the characters say. For example, the wolf says, "Little pig, little pig, let me come in."



Next week, we will continue to do activities based on this story. We will also be learning the names of farm animals and their young.

As part of celebrating Earth Day, the children have been learning facts about the importance of recycling and keeping our planet clean. They also made lovely representations of the Earth using blue paint and green hand prints.

Reception Place Offers

You should have received an email offering a Reception place for your child in September. Many of the children have places allocated at Roe Green Infant School, but they have not been accepted. **Please make sure that you accept this offer by 30/4/26. Your child will lose their place in Reception if you do not accept the offer.**

Encouraging independence

We are teaching the children to be as independent as possible in the Nursery. You can help us by encouraging your child to put their own coat and shoes on independently.

Toilet training

Some of the children are still coming into the Nursery wearing a pull-up or nappy. Please help your child by continuing to toilet-train them at home so they can become independent in using the toilet.

Reminder:

The children change books on Mondays. They need to bring in their book bag every **Monday**.

Please make sure that your child is with you at all times when on the school grounds, before and after school.



Next week we will be learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To understand how to make friends when feeling lonely.

Communication & Language:

- To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- We will be reading the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'.

Literacy:

- To join in with the repeated refrains and key phrases in the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', for example, "Little pig, little pig let me come in."
- We will continue to learn the letter and sound '**b**', for example, **bat**, **ball**, **boy**. Please bring in something from home beginning with this letter sound/name to share with the class.

Mathematics:

- We will be counting sets of objects and saying a number name for each of them e.g. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.

Expressive Arts & Design:

- We will be making crafts linked to the learning of the letter name and sound '**b**'.

Superhero Day

To celebrate the Year of Reading, we would like to invite children to come dressed as a superhero on Friday 1st May. This could be a real-life superhero, such as a fire fighter, police officer or nurse or a fictional superhero such as Spiderman or Elsa. We would appreciate a donation of £1 or more. 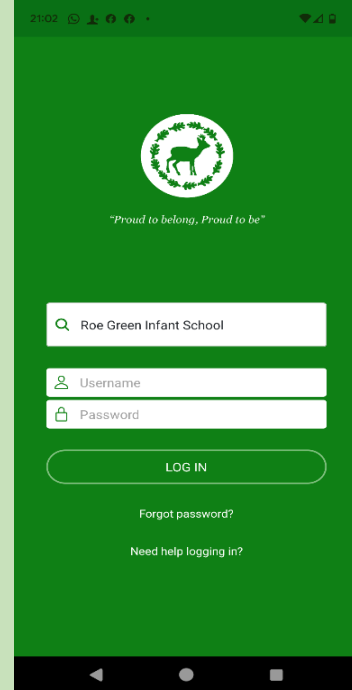

How to add money on to your School Ping account

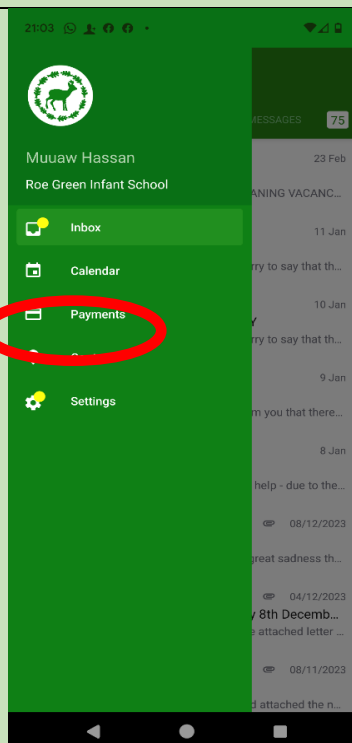
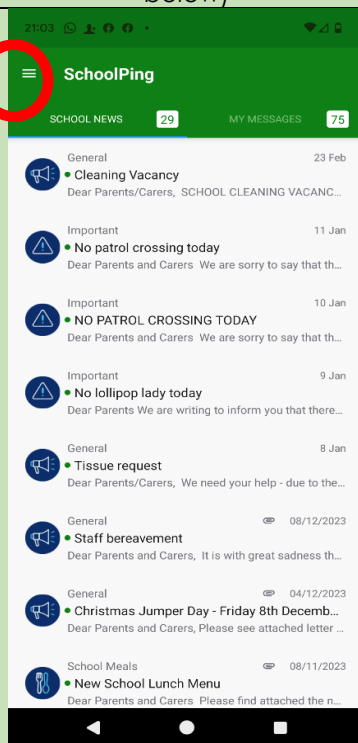
If you have not done so already, please download SchoolPing app from the Play store or App store. Alternatively you can log on from a PC using the following address :

Please 'Find your school' by typing Roe Green Infant School and then Login (if not already) using your details

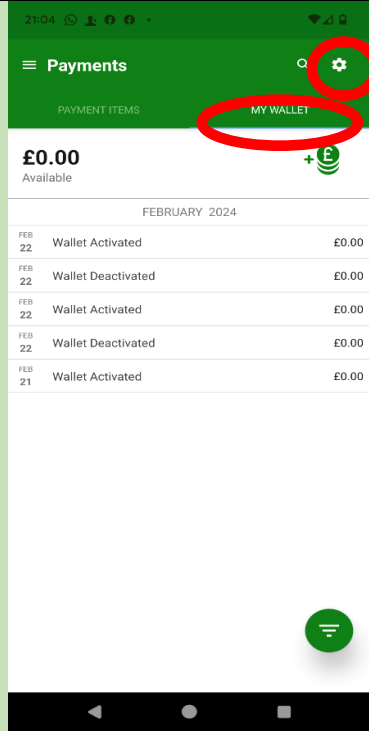


From the main screen please go to the menu which is the three line on the top (as indicated below)

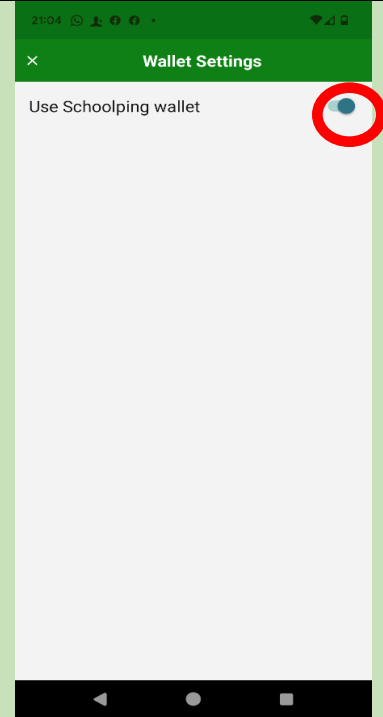
Then select Payments from the menu (as indicated below)



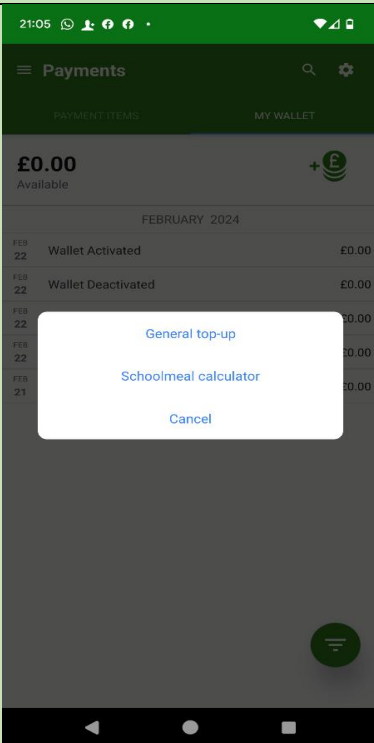
Once you select Payments, please choose the 'My Wallet' tab on the top and then select the setting button in the top right corner (as indicated below)
