Dear Parents,

This week we have been busy making Eid cards for our families and talking about the different festivals that we celebrate. We have also been talking about the life cycle of a butterfly and have continued our observations of the caterpillars in our class. The children have been fascinated to see that our caterpillars are not tiny anymore... they are now big, fat caterpillars! Next week, once the cocoons have been made, we will transfer them to the butterfly net.



Next week, we will be learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To understand that it is important to wash your hands before eating and after going to the toilet. Please reinforce this practice at home. We will be making chocolate nests in the Nursery this week.

Communication & Language:

- To understand a question or an instruction that has two parts. The children will be following instructions to make their chocolate nests and Easter cards.

Literacy:

- The letter name and sound 'l'. For example, lollipop and lion. Please bring in something from home beginning with this letter name/sound to share with the class.

Mathematics:

- To say one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5. Encourage your child to practise their counting skills at home. For example, counting the number of steps as you walk up a staircase, counting how many socks are on the washing line outside or how many flowers are growing in your garden/park.

Physical Development:

- To be more independent in our self-care. In the Nursery, we are encouraging the children to manage their own clothing, wiping their nose when needed and putting the dirty tissue in the bin, and also washing and drying their hands independently. We would appreciate it if you could also encourage this independence at home.

Expressive Arts & Design:

- We will be making Easter cards and chocolate nests in the Nursery this week.

Understanding the World:

- To understand why our Christian friends celebrate Easter. The children will be listening to a simple version of the Easter story on Cbeebies. Here is a link if you would like to share this story with your child at home: [Easter Story - Cbeebies - BBC](#)
