Dear Parents,

The Nursery Team would like to welcome all of our families back for the summer term. We hope that you had a lovely Easter break. We would also like to welcome the new children who started in the Nursery on Tuesday.

This week, the children have been settling back into the Nursery and learning to share and play sensibly with their friends. We have been talking about what we did in the Easter holidays and learning to use longer sentences. On Tuesday, the children decorated a picture of the Earth to celebrate Earth Day 2025. We talked about how we can care for our planet by doing simple things such as recycling paper and cardboard and by picking up litter in our playground.

This term, our theme in the Nursery is 'Growing'. We will be learning about farm animals.

Next week, we will be reading the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. If you have this book at home, read it to your child and encourage them to join in with some of the repeated language. Next week we will be learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To understand how to make friends when feeling lonely.

Communication & Language:

- To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- We will be reading the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'.

Literacy:

- To join in with the repeated refrains and key phrases in the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', for example, "Little pig, little pig let me come in."
- We will continue to learn the letter and sound 'b', for example, **bat**, **ball**, **boy**. Please bring in something from home beginning with this letter sound/name to share with the class.

Mathematics:

- We will be counting sets of objects and saying a number name for each of them e.g. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.

Expressive Arts & Design:

- We will be making crafts linked to the learning of the letter name and sound 'b'.

Reminder:

The children change books on Mondays. They need to bring in their book bag every **Monday**.

Please make sure that your child is with you at all times when on the school grounds, before and after school.

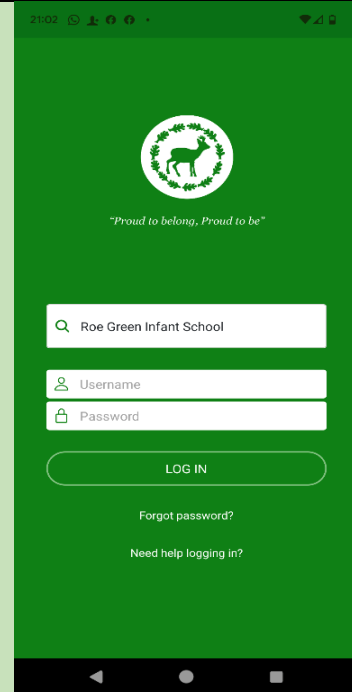
Reception Place Offers

How to add money on to your School Ping account

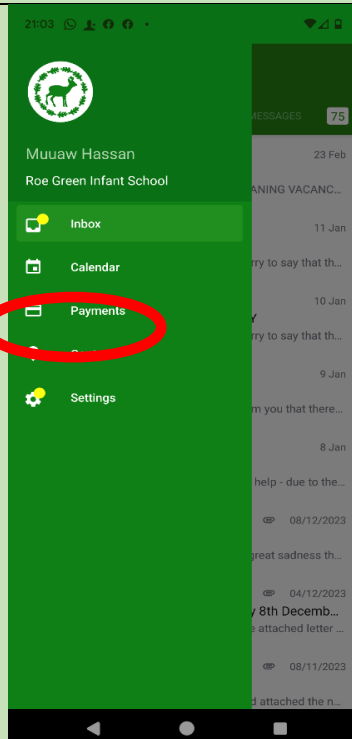
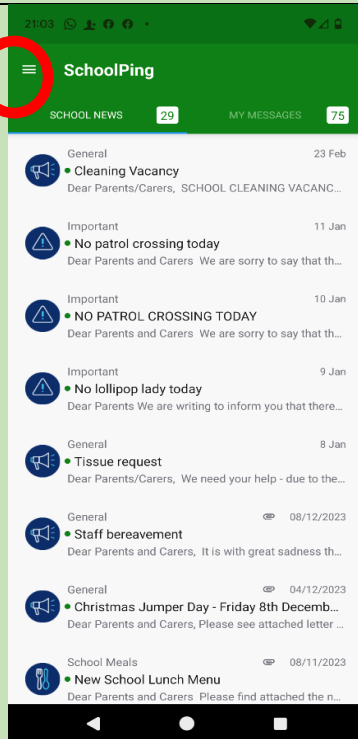

Please 'Find your school' by typing Roe Green Infant School and then Login (if not already) using your details

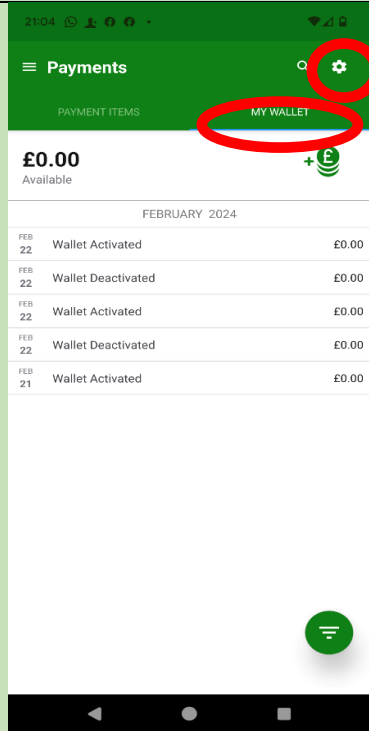


From the main screen please go to the menu which is the three line on the top (as indicated below)

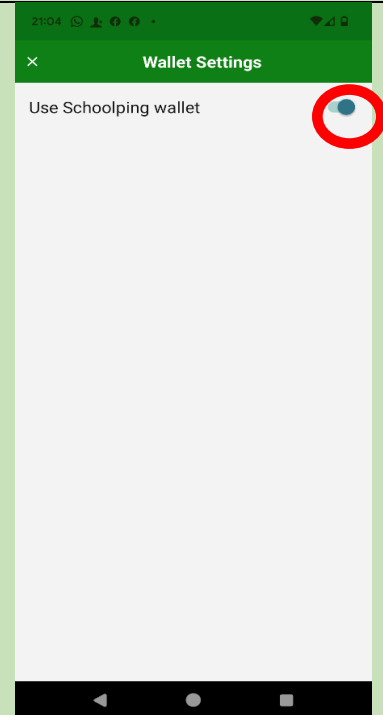
Then select Payments from the menu (as indicated below)



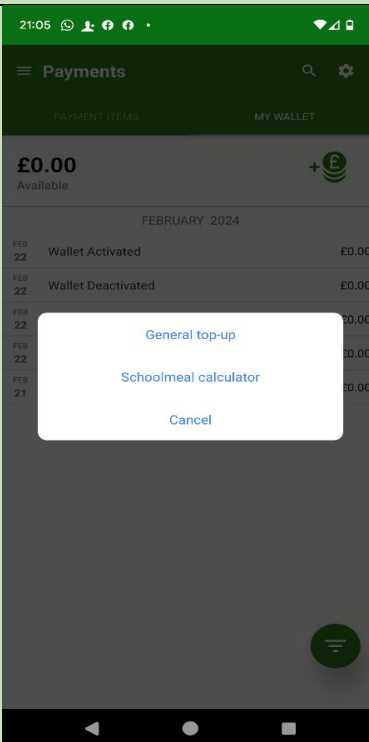
Once you select Payments, please choose the 'My Wallet' tab on the top and then select the setting button in the top right corner (as indicated below)
