Communication & Language:

- We will be talking about what we did during the Christmas holidays.

Literacy:

- We will be singing nursery rhymes.
- We will be painting pictures of our holiday news and giving meaning to the marks that we make. At home, you could encourage your child to draw a picture of something that you did during the Christmas holiday. It would be lovely to share your child's drawing with the rest of the Nursery.

- To be able to count to at least 5, then beyond.
