## Dear Parents,

If your child has a place in Reception at our school, you will have been invited to meet your child's Reception teacher next week.

Your child should come to their Nursery session as normal on these days. If your child is already at Nursery during the time of your visit, please arrive 10 minutes early to pick up your child. A member of staff will be at the **Nursery gate** to greet you. Parents, please wait with your child in the Nursery garden for a member of staff to come and take you to the meeting. The meetings will take place in the **Evergreen building**.

This week, we have been learning the letter name and sound **qu**. Qu is for **question mark**, **queen** and **quiet**. We talked about what a question mark means and what it looks like. The children also practised their cutting skills and learned to sequence numbers in the correct order.

Please bring in as many junk modelling materials as you can to help us make our masterpieces! We will also begin to practise our songs for the Nursery graduation ceremonies.



## **Next week we will be learning:**

### **Personal, Social and Emotional Development:**

- To accept the needs of others and take turns and share resources, sometimes with support from others.
- The children going to Reception will be meeting their new teachers and visiting their new classrooms with their parents.

### **Physical Development:**

- We will be using scissors to cut along lines and around shapes.

### **Communication & Language/Expressive Arts & Design:**

- To respond to simple instructions. We will be making crafts linked to the theme of the "Authors from All Around the World."

### **Literacy:**

- We will be revising all of the letter names and sounds of the alphabet.

### **Mathematics:**

- We will be talking about 2D and 3D shapes when making our art work.
