Home Learning: 22nd - 26th April 2024

Next week we will be learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To understand how to make friends when feeling lonely.

Communication & Language:

- To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- We will be reading the story of 'The Three Little Pigs.'

Literacy:

- To join in with the repeated refrains and key phrases in the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', for example, "Little pig, little pig let me come in."
- We will continue to learn the letter and sound '**f**', for example, fish, frog, farm.

Mathematics:

- We will be counting sets of objects and saying a number name for each of them. E.g. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.

Expressive Arts & Design:

- We will be making crafts linked to the learning of the letter name and sound '**f**'.

Reminder:

The children change books on Mondays. They need to bring in their book bag every **Monday**.

Please make sure that your child is with you at all times when on the school grounds, before and after school.
