Self-Portraits

Next week, the children will be making self-portraits. We will be talking about the features on our faces and reinforcing key vocabulary such as eyes, nose, mouth, lips, ears, eye brows, hair etc. Please help your child to learn these words.

We will also be singing 'body songs' during singing sessions. You can find the following songs on www.youtube.com or you can visit the BBC website for nursery rhymes.

- Heads, Shoulders, Knees & Toes
- Tommy Thumb
- One Finger, One Thumb Keep Moving
- Hokey Cokey



Reminder - Book Bags:

A letter will go out to parents via School Ping nearer to the time.

Next week we are learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To know that there are lots of different houses and homes.

Communication & Language/ Understanding the World:

- Understand a question or instruction that has 2 parts, such as, "Get your coat and wait at the door."

Literacy:

- The letter and sound 'i' e.g. ink, in, igloo. At home, you could play the 'I Spy' game and find things beginning with this letter in your home.
- To draw our face and body.

Please bring in an object beginning with the letter name/ sound 'i' from home. E.g. a toy insect or igloo.

Mathematics:

- To take part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- To recite number names in sequence from 1 to at least 5, then beyond.

Physical Development:

- To be able to use one handed tools and implements. At home you could encourage your child to hold and use scissors correctly to make snips in paper.

Expressive Art and Design:

- To use different resources to make self-portraits. At home, you could play an interactive 'Make a face' game by clicking on the link below.
