Next week we are learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- To be able to follow rules and understand why they are important.

Physical Development:

- To take part in team games. We will be practising for Sports Day. Sports Day is on Wednesday 24th June.

Communication & Language:

- To be able to follow 2 part instructions. For example, get your coat and line up.

Literacy:

- We will be learning the letter name and sound 'qu' e.g. queen, quack and question mark. Please bring in something beginning with this letter name and sound to share with the class.

Expressive Arts & Design:

- We will be taking part in art and craft activities linked to the theme of 'Authors from all Around the World'.

Mathematics:

- To be able to say a number for each item in order. For example; 1,2,3,4,5. At home, you could put your toys in a line and count how many you have.



- We will also be learning to recognise and order numbers from 1-5, then beyond.
